We will be working in smaller journals such as Dylusions Dyalog (any one except black pages), Dylusions A5 size, Art by Marlene A5 size or similar.

Your favourite watersoluble media to colour focal images – you might like to bring a selection of – watercolours,

Distress inks, Scribble Sticks or Ecoline markers

Gel Press if you have one, any size will do

Brayer

Sheet A4 watercolour paper for stamping images

Stamps & blocks for focal images – I have used Art by Marlene Heart & Darkroom Door butterflies but anything similar will work

Permanent stamping ink in black (not Stazon ink please – Ranger Archival brand is the best)

Permanent stamping ink in colours – bring what you have

Stickers for quote (Tim Holtz produces some fabulous sheets of words/quotes)

A variety of brushes in various sizes.

A variety of stencils with random type patterns

Fine scissors for fussy cutting focal images

Wet glue for sticking down focal images

A variety of acrylic paints

White gesso if you have it

Stabilo pencil

White gel pen or white Posca

Paint palette – one with separate wells will be very useful

Palette knife

Non-stick craft mat

Spray bottle for water

Sponges

Baby wipes

Paper towel

Container for water

Dimensional Magic

We will be using a bit of this, and it will take time, so to save waiting so much a bottle of your own is good (glossy accents or another brand is ok too)

Heat gun

Again, we will be using these a lot, so your own is good, there will be some in class too but not enough for everyone.

Fan, foam and soft bristle brush and palette knife (or wooden tongue depressor)

Heat gun

Hot glue gun
