Mixed Media Art Journaling – Mixed Media Faces with Robyn Wood

Sunday February 5, 10am – 2pm

We will be working in an A4 sized art journal and please have on hand:

Collage materials – thin scrapbook paper, book pages, printed tissue paper, paper napkins, maps, tickets, monoprinted pages and any ephemera you would like to add to your page. Magazines are a great source and my favourites are Daphne's Diary, Flow, Collective & Frankie

Colouring pencils or watercolour pencils in some bright colours plus brown & black

Other watersoluble colours will be useful but not necessary (eg Distress crayons or Gelatos)

Graphite paper for transferring face sketch or you can draw it freehand

Archival ink in black and 1-2 other colours

Charcoal pencil

A couple of your favourite stencils that feature patterns of different sizes

Charcoal pencil & paper blending stump (ear buds will also work)

Matt gel medium

Liquitex white gesso & matt medium

Palette knife

Approx. 1" wide brush and a variety of smaller brushes

Soft lead pencil (6-8B) & eraser

Black permanent pen

White Sharpie paint pen

2–3 matt acrylic paints in warm & cool colours (Distress & Dylusions paints are perfect). Also bring if you have it a skin colour, but I'll have some to share so don't need to buy special.

Small sponges for paint
Gift card for scraping paint
Mark making tools – sequin waste, bubble wrap, assorted plastic lids
Paint palette
Non-stick craft mat
Baby wipes
Paper towel
Container for water
Heat tool
Gloves

N.B. Please ensure you bring 'matt' paints along – glossy ones tend to stick in an art journal.
