MIXED MEDIA ART JOURNALING – LIVE IN THE MOMENT with Robyn Wood Sunday March 4th 10.00am – 2.00pm

For this class we will be using DecoArt Media Crackle Medium & Fluid Acrylics and some paints will be available for use in class. If you have your own, please bring them along to save waiting. I will also provide the cheesecloth which forms part of the textural element on the page. A butterfly image will be provided for use in class, you may wish to bring your own to trace if you would like something a little different.

We will be working in an A4 sized journal and please have on hand –

White tissue paper for background texture, approx. half the page is covered. I use tissue recycled from packaging

Stickers for a word/quote if you wish to add something to the page at the end

2-3 acrylic paints for background – I have used a mix of blues, green and an earthy colour (see note above)

Acrylic paints in butterfly colours for main image

DecoArt Media Crackle Medium or other clear crackle medium (see note above)

2-3 stencils with open patterns for background

Fluid acrylic paints – assorted colours (to match your background colours), plus one beige shade for the face (I use Jo Sonja Smoked Pearl)

Medium round brush (for background paint)

Paint brush for collaging

Palette knife – small (metal or plastic is fine)

Vine charcoal

Charcoal pencil – soft or medium (I use General Peel and Sketch soft)

Old credit card or piece of plastic to smooth collage

White soft pastel - Rembrandt is the best I have found, it has good sticking power

White heavy duty acrylic paint

Canvas – 12×16" (stretched or canvas board, or wood panel)

Clear acrylic spray sealer – satin or matt finish (optional)

We will be working in an A4 sized journal and please have on hand -

2-3 acrylic paints for background – I have used shades of pink

2-3 stencils with small patterns for background

Chalk inks in pale flower & leaf colours (if you have them)

Fine scissors for fussy cutting butterflies

White gesso
