MIXED MEDIA ART JOURNALING – PERFECTLY IMPERFECT with Robyn Wood

Sunday May 7, 10am – 2pm

We will be working in an A4 sized journal and please have on hand –

I will provide you with the reference images of lotus flowers that I have used. If you would like to paint something different please bring along some images to use and you will need a main image approx. 13cm across plus a single or two smaller images approx. 4cm across. Profile type images will work best.

A couple of your favourite stencils, some with open patterns plus text, numbers or words

Liquitex white gesso

Texture paste

Pallet knife

approx. 1" wide brush

variety of smaller brushes including a small fine one

Graphite paper or similar if you wish to trace a flower instead of drawing one

Pencil & rubber

Stabilo pencil if you have one

black permanent pen

white Sharpie paint pen or white gel pen

matt acrylic paints in warm & cool colours plus a deep blue and black (Distress & Dylusions paints are perfect). You will need the main colours for your flowers plus some others that are in the opposite colour family.

small sponges for paint

texture type stamps if you have them. I have used chicken wire & mesh from Darkroom Door.

Clear Versamark ink & white embossing powder if you have them.

non-stick craft mat

baby wipes

paper towel

container for water

heat tool

gloves

N.B. Please ensure you bring 'matt' paints along – glossy ones tend to stick in an art journal

Glues... You will need several different glues.wet glue, fast drying glue with fine tip /450/tartans grip. Heat gun if you have one, (I will have mine available.)

You will need a fine tip applicator for your wet glue.

Attaching the designer paper to the card stock my preference is(distress collage medium matte)

You may prefer modpodge , or your wet glue

1/4&1/2 tapes(my preference is artisan tape by Prima(Deb has this)
Brown ink and applicator (walnut stain ink by ranger)
Splat mat
Paint brushes and water container
Small bottle of water spray .
Paper towel/baby wipes.
Heat tool
Small bulldog clips,if you have them , (I will have a supply of them if you don't.)

To alter the frame, we will be using Prima memory hardware artisan powder in umber & inka gold in Alt silver.

You will need a small brush for this and larger ones for medium you use for attaching designer papers. (the artisan powder and inka gold is included in your kit)

Please have your own equipment from the requirement list, this is a long class and no time for sharing of tools.
