MIXED MEDIA ART JOURNALING – SHAKE THE WORLD with Robyn Wood

We will be working in an A4 sized journal and please have on hand –

Collage material – see note below

Stamps – Robyn will be using a mix of texture type images (numbers, letters, spots, mesh, circles, text) plus some others to build the character. If you have anything that seems suitable – bring it along.

A variety of stencils with detail type patterns – think text, small shapes, arrows and the like

A variety of acrylic paints

A variety of paint brushes including a wide one suitable for gel medium

Black Stabilo or black watercolour pencil/charcoal pencil – Bella Paperie now has these in stock

White gel pen & black permanent pen may be useful for doodling

Black & coloured permanent stamping ink (Ranger Archival brand preferred, not Stazon). Please bring what you have and we will have some to share.

Matt medium

White gesso

Liquitex matt gel medium (available from Bella Paperie, usual matt medium will not be strong enough)

Paint palette – one with separate wells will be very useful

Please Note:

Robyn will show you how to create your own ephemera for collage using patterned paper, stamps and stencils and will bring a selection of materials for use.

Please bring your own as well if you have something suitable – think printed clothing tags, ticket stubs, gel printed papers, scrapbook papers in neutral tones, text paper, unusual imagery from books/magazines (but no glossy papers).

Robyn will provide the background image for the image transfer (large circular wheel) but if you wish to use your own please bring printed onto photocopy paper using either a photocopier or laser printer. Ink jet printed images may not be successful.
