We will be working in smaller journals such as Dylusions Dyalog (any one except black pages), Dylusions A5 size, Art by Marlene A5 size or similar.

Come prepared with your favourite quote to feature on one of the pages – I'll show you how to hand letter it
Your favourite watersoluble media to colour focal images and backgrounds – you might like to bring a selection of – watercolours, Distress inks, Scribble Sticks or Ecoline markers. My samples have used watercolours and Distress inks.

Sheet A4 watercolour paper for stamping images

Stamps & blocks for focal images

Permanent stamping ink in black (not Stazon ink please – Ranger Archival brand is the best)

A variety of brushes in various sizes
A variety of stencils with random type patterns
Fine scissors for fussy cutting focal images
Wet glue for sticking down focal images
A variety of acrylic paints
Glitter pens in a variety of colours if you have them
White gesso if you have it
White gel pen or white Posca
Permanent black pen – Copic multiliner, black Posca or similar
Paint palette – one with separate wells will be very useful
Palette knife
Non-stick craft mat
Spray bottle for water
Sponges
Baby wipes
Paper towel
Container for water
Heat tool

N.B. **There will be limited supplies to share of items such as stencils, stamps and ink pads.**
