STAMPERIA LADY VAGABOND INTERACTIVE LAYOUT

With Jenny \$49 Includes Materials Kit

Want to get lots of photos on a layout? Want an interesting layout that has interactive elements that can be lifted, pulled or opened to reveal hidden areas? In this month's class, we will create a double layout with space for 31 photos. It has plenty of "openable" areas to showcase all your favourite photos. CARDS

Sir Vagabond Cards

With Annette \$44 including materials kit

This pack of cards combines the amazing depiction & illustrations of Steampunk, which was inspired by 19th Century industrial steam powered technology with a refined slightly weird Sir Vagabond, a nomadic person who wanders from place to place. It is an extraordinary artistic combination designed by Antonis Tzanidakis from Stamperia which while is so original and wonderful it also verges on the ridiculous. I really enjoyed creating these cards and I am sure you will too.

Gift Wallet

With Patricia \$22 including materials kit

This gift wallet could be used for any occasion. The design will be printed directly on the vellum to reduce time needed for tracing, so that you can concentrate of the parchment skills of embossing – freehand and on a grid, perforating through a grid and using a two needle tool and snips to create a shaped edge. A separate pocket is created on the inside of the card to hold a voucher or cash. The wallet is closed with a magnetic closure. Acknowledgement: The original mandala design was from a colouring page on the internet: mondaymandala.com. I have used a variety of parchment techniques to embellish the design instead of colouring.

LADY VAGABOND NOTEBOOK

Happy New Year everyone... looking forward to my first class for the year. I have enjoyed making this class using Stamperia "Lady Vagabond" collection and different mixed media techniques to create this A4 hard covered notebook. Using some Stamperia aqua colours and liquid acrylics from Finnabair you will create this leather look background, stenciled with pastes and then decorated using rice paper and chipboard that you magically turn into the rust effect. Leave it as a notebook or change it into a junk journal.

Artist Brush Canister

with Sue Smyth \$48 including kit

As artists we all need somewhere to store our brushes, and something to transport them around is great too. We make this one of a kind cannister, plenty of room to personalize. We play with waxes and alcohol inks and use some everyday items to decorate, a definite must for the mixed media fan.

Book of Secrets

This book has a secret, it is not a book but a box, perfectly created to hide precious items and mysterious treasures. You will learn how to easily convert an old book into a box, and then decorate it with lots of resin and metals, creating a glorious aged background for the cover. We use some ordinary items in novel ways and learn lots of technique that you will use over and over again. A must for the mixed media fan.

Grandma's Vase

With Tracey White \$40 includes some materials

Mixed media class with a torn "vintage wallpaper" background, making our vase with Rose Gold Texture and stencil. Using collaged paper leaves in the background and stencils for the floral arrangement. No hand painted flowers! Just techniques to embellish your stencils to look more natural. My grandmother always had a vase of flowers on the table, did yours? Come and add to your mixed media skills!

Bookings are essential for all crops.

Cropping is when you gather with friends to work on your paper crafts.

When you come to Bella Paperie to do your craft, we try to make you feel at home without all the distractions. You get to meet new people, enjoy the fun of being with others and learn new things from the people around you. We have cutting tools like the Sizzix machine & cuttlebug. These are free for your use when you crop. If you don't know how to use the machines, we will help you. Of course, evenings are the most popular because you can crop for 5 hours –Dinner, supper and tea & coffee included. Wow, what a deal! Coming here to crop doesn't mean you have to be scrapbooking. Some women come to work on their off the page projects, card making, stamping, or even making costumes! You are welcome to do any craft. During our crops you are able to copy the current store samples.

CLASS POLICIES

Classes must be paid for when you make your booking in order to secure your place. Late cancellations (within 48 hours of a scheduled class) will result in a forfeit of your class fee. If we cancel a class/crop, you may use your class payment as a credit towards another, or receive your money back. Any classes with a kit require a minimum of 1 weeks' notice if you wish to cancel your class. You will be given your cancelled class fee as a refund or credit. If we receive less than 1 weeks' notice, you will only receive the class materials kit.

Classes are for your personal use only. If you sell and/or teach stamping and/or scrapbooking supplies & classes for financial gain, please refrain from attending our classes and events

CLASS PREPARATION

To make sure you get maximum enjoyment out of your class, please ensure you have gathered your necessary supplies **before the class**. The store doors will be locked until 10 minutes before evening, Sunday & "first up" classes are due to start, after which time the teacher will be welcoming students & helping you settle, ready to start the class on time.

We are open 6 days a week, and are happy to help you pick your supplies for your upcoming class during store hours. *Please mark all of your belongings clearly, & check that you have them at the end of the class.*

BASIC CLASS KIT Required for every class

You will need to bring a basic tool kit of a ruler, pencil, rubber, 12inch/30.5cm paper trimmer, craft knife, reamer, bone scorer, baby wipes, double sided & foam tape & glues along to all classes, including those in which a kit is provided. **Please check the blog for any additional class requirements.
