Please note – with the exception of consumables, the items below are all available from Bella Paperie. Purchase of substitute items may lead to disappointment if they are not suitable for the techniques taught.

We will be working in smaller journals such as Dylusions Dyalog (any one except black pages), Dylusions A5 size, Art by Marlene A5 size or similar.

Distress Ink and Distress Oxide Inks in a variety of colours for backgrounds and focal images - please bring what you have as colour choices on the day may change, there will also be some classroom inks for use. Acrylic paint may be substituted for some of the techniques taught.

Sponging tool or brushes for inks

White gesso

Matt medium

White cheesecloth if you have it but I will bring some to share

Sheet A4 watercolour paper for stamping images

Stamps & blocks for focal images

Stamped or printed quotes for page titles – I will have some available

Permanent stamping ink in black (not Stazon ink please – Ranger Archival brand is the best)

Wet glue for sticking down focal images, you may like some foam tape

White wax pencil or white crayon

White gel pen or white Posca, optional

~ 15cm of twine or thin ribbon if you wish to use a bottle image

Basics to bring to each class:

A variety of brushes in various sizes

Fine scissors for fussy cutting focal images
Paint palette – one with separate wells will be very useful
Palette knife
Non-stick craft mat
Spray bottle for water
Sponges
Baby wipes
Paper towel
Container for water
Heat tool
