Current art journaling kit including: A4 sized journal, Liquitex white gesso, Liquitex matt medium, texture paste, palette knife, approx. 1" wide brush, variety of smaller brushes, black permanent ink, pencil, rubber, black permanent pen, white Sharpie paint pen, 2-3 matt acrylic paints in warm & cool colours (Distress & Dylusions paints are perfect), small sponges for paint, collage material if

you have it, spray bottle, non-stick craft mat, baby wipes, paper towel, container for water, heat tool, gloves (if you don't like paint on your hands). Please ensure you bring 'matt' paints along – glossy ones tend to stick in an art journal.
